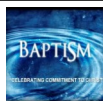

BEREAVEMENT MINISTRY

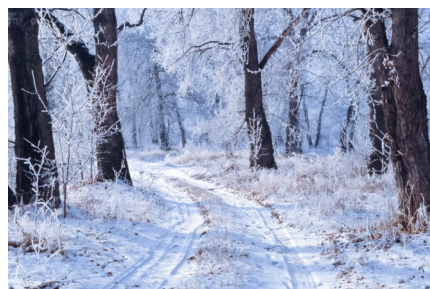


St. Robert Bereavement Ministry
