

ST. ROBERT 4K-5th GRADE SPRING CONCERT INFORMATION

4K-5th Grade students have been working hard and are excited to present to you their Spring Concert!

Thursday, May 18, 2017 at 6:30pm in the St. Robert School Gymnasium.

CALL TIME & LOCATION

Your child should report to his or her classroom at 6:15pm. Students are required to report back to their classrooms after they perform and can be picked up there after the concert.

ATTIRE

Students should wear khaki pants with a nice pastel-colored blouse or polo-type shirt. Girls may also wear nice skirts or dresses. All students should wear shoes that are comfortable to walk and stand in for an extended period of time, and that will not fall off easily.

ATTENDANCE

All students are expected and required to participate in the concert. It is a part of their grade and attendance will be taken. Performing is a National Standard and Proficiency that all students are required to meet. When preparing for a performance, students learn to **work as a team**, **contribute** to the group, and **trust** each other to do their best. In addition, many students have been given certain duties to perform at the concert (such as a solo, speaking part, playing an instrument, etc). Everyone has a job and everyone is important. All students will be relying on each other to do their parts, and the absence of even one student negatively affects the group as a whole.

If there are uncontrollable circumstances that prevent your child's participation in the concert, please contact Mrs. Janisch ASAP. If your child is too sick to perform at the concert, please email Mrs. Janisch or call the school office and leave a note for her as early as possible. Although no assignment or assessment can replace the experience of a live performance, students who are unable to participate in the concert will be required to complete an alternate assignment. This will apply to all grades, regardless of age, and there are no exceptions.
